R.E: Road Race at Broadland High School

Dear Sir/Madam

I am writing to you to make you aware of an upcoming series of 5 kilometer races that the Norwich Road Runners will host from Broadland High School. The first race has already taken place in which we did not inform you about the series as we have in the past. Please accept our apologies if this caused you any inconvenience.

The next two races will be on 13<sup>th</sup> June and Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> July. Both have a start time of 7:15pm, with runners arriving from 6pm onwards at Broadland High School.

In order to ensure the safety of our runners, and to facilitate an orderly start, we have applied for, and been granted, a temporary road closure for Tunstead Road from Norfolk County Council, allowing us to have the start of the race on the road and be free from traffic. This road closure will be from 7:05pm to 7:20pm, and cannot be more than 15 minutes long.

During this 15 minute period no vehicles will be allowed to use Tunstead Road, from either direction. Marshals and a barrier will be present at all junctions connecting to Tunstead Road, to halt traffic. We will ensure any emergency services are given full access during this time. After the start of the race the road will be open, however there will be marshals and runners present along Tunstead Road until 8pm.

I appreciate this will mean that Tunstead Road will be inaccessible for a period of 15 minutes, however we believe that closing the road, for this brief period of time, is the best way to ensure the safety of our runners, and to minimise the possibility of any accidents occurring. I apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.
