The minutes of the meeting held on 7th November 2023 were proposed as a correct record without amendment by Cllr. Phillipo; seconded by Cllr. Coleman and AGREED by all. They were duly signed by the Chair.

District/County CIIr. Nigel Dixon reported on the County Council devolution deal with a directly elected leader in May 2024; May 2025 County Council elections; Change in household DIY waste – no charges for certain quantities; Norfolk Fire & Rescue Service 3 year building programme to update facilities and improve provisions for female firefighters; Care services received over 800 calls over Christmas period; From 1 February 2024 all Norfolk residents who hold a disabled concessionary travel pass will be eligible for free bus travel 24 hours a day, seven days a week when travelling within the county; MP Duncan Baker holding a public flooding meeting on Friday 7th February at Hickling; At District Council - the Local Plan (2024-2039) is with the planning inspectorate for examination. It was asked of there were any issues with refuse collections in the Parish – none reported. The Chair spoke about the closure of Meyton Wood Recycling Centre. There was a public consultation last year, however the majority were against the closure.

The General Reserve Policy was AGREED – to hold approx. 6 months Precept.

It was proposed by Cllr. Phillipo; seconded by Cllr. Ramsbottom and AGREED by all to increase the Precept to £4,520 (approx. 5%/£213 increase). This will result in a Band D increase to 67.06 which is an increase of £4.54 per Band D property.
